



Resident Membership

Frequently Asked Questions

- Q. What is a Resident Membership?
- A. Resident members are deemed “Equity” members in the Club and are entitled to full and complete use of all club facilities. A Resident membership is a “family” membership that extends all privileges to the member’s spouse and dependent children under the age of 24.
- Q. Can single members appoint a “Significant Other” to share in his or her membership?
- A. Yes, a Single Member may designate a “Significant Other” per the Club policy.
- Q. Do you offer Junior memberships?
- A. Yes, to qualify for a Junior membership, you must have a parent who is a Resident member of the club.
- Q. Are there any restrictions on the golf course?
- A. Yes, the course is available to Resident members at almost any time, with the exception of Monday mornings (Closed) and Tuesday mornings (Ladies Day). Please contact the Pro Shop for further details.
- Q. Can I take my child out to play golf/practice with me?
- A. Yes, you can take your children out on the Golf Course. Dependent hours of play are listed in detail in the Club Rules. Children must be at least 8 years old to play. Children/grandchildren ages 4-7 may

accompany a parent/grandparent on the course as observers only, and in order to practice, must be "directly" supervised at all times.

Q. Can I bring guests to play golf with me?

A. Yes, guests are welcome to play with a member in accordance to Club Rules. All guests may play a maximum of 6 times per calendar year, regardless of which member they play with. All guests must be accompanied by a member during play.

Q. When is the Pool open, and can I bring guests?

A. The Pool opens the Saturday before Memorial Day, through the weekend. It reopens the Friday after Memorial Day, then is open 7 days a week through Labor Day. Your guests are welcome at the Pool for the daily fee currently in effect.
